Important Warnings

1) In order to confirm the safety of use, please be sure to modify the default factory password after completing the software and hardware installation of the camera. If you do not modify the password, you will be in danger of being logged in illegally.

2) Please ensure your password is at least 8-10 characters long and contains a combination of lowercase characters, uppercase characters as well as numbers.

3) Please ensure your 2.4G Wi-Fi password not include special characters like" \ " & = ", these are not supported by Topodome cameras. If your Wi-Fi password includes any of these special characters, please login your router to change Wi-Fi password and remove these special chars.

4) When camera is powered on, it will take about one minute to finish the start-up procedure, in this time, your APP or CMS software or browsers will not operate the camera, and you can not reset the camera in this time also.

5) Please note that after the first installation of the camera in the mobile APP, it will default to the smooth mode (SD), which is to ensure the speed of browsing; if you want higher definition, please click and switch to the HD mode.


6) The time zone of the camera is GMT+8 when it leaves the factory, please modify the time zone to make it consistent with your time zone, otherwise your video file will show the wrong time.

7) Please use the Intelligent tracking function in the APP software with caution. Sometimes it may cause false alarms and change the monitoring angle of the camera.

1. Features

1.1. Overview

Topodome Security camera, suitable for various applications, including home, office and small business. Topodome camera can not only meet the needs of ordinary households, but also can use enhanced functions to connect to some professional software and equipment to achieve higher efficiency. The following are the basic appearance and functions of the TD-Sx series cameras.



2. Camera Setup Guide


Installing the camera requires two parts: hardware installation and software installation. In just a few simple steps, you can get online video from your mobile phone or PC.

2.1. Hardware Installation

2.1.1 Please pay attention to plug the **power adapter** into the AC socket, and then connect the DC interface of the camera to the power adapter. And please **take out the antenna** in the package, find the interface on the camera, and tighten it.



2.1.2 If it is more convenient to connect the camera to the router with a network cable, we strongly recommend this first. Of course, you can also connect the hotspot signal of the camera to complete the installation. This method is described in detail later.



2.2. Software Installation

There are three modes of camera software installation: 1) Installation via App "**CamHiPro**" 2) Installation via professional CMS software 3) Installation via browser.

2.3. Installed on the buildings

Topodome TD-Sx series camera bracket has a detachable mounting piece. When installing, the customer can fix the mounting piece on the wall first, and then insert the camera bracket into the mounting piece to easily complete the installation.



2.4. Default Username and Password

To login to the system for the first time, use one of the following default username/password combinations. Once you've successfully logged in, it is highly recommended to change the password for security reasons.

Username: admin

Password: admin

Note:

1. Changing the password for admin account is necessary with prompt during initial setup.

2. The password is case sensitive.

3. If you forget the username/password, or fail to login the camera with any usernames/passwords you know, press the hard reset button of the device for 5-10 seconds, the camera will restore factory settings (you can hear music play) and you can login it with default password.

3. Setup Camera with Mobile Phones

3.1. Download and Install CamHiPro App on your mobile phone

To access your camera on a mobile device, please search and download the "CamHiPro" App from Apple Store or Google Play, and then install it.

Note:

1. The software interface on this manual may be slightly different from the actual downloaded software, which is caused by the version.

2. Currently the camera supports 2.4GHz band only. So if you have a dual band router, please only connect to 2.4G band.

3. The username and password are case sensitive.

3.2. Set up a new camera


Before installing your new camera, please confirm that you have connected the power adapter and installed the antenna according to the above instructions.

If you are not familiar with hotspot installation, we strongly recommend that you **use a network cable** (prepared in the box) to connect the camera to the router and complete the first installation. Then you can configure the wireless connection and finally realize the wireless connection of the camera to the internet.

If you don't want to connect the network cable, you can follow the hotspot installation method to complete the software installation of the camera, but it should be noted that the camera must be close to the router during installation to prevent poor signal from causing installation failure.


3.2.1. Run the APP of "CamHipro"

After the camera is powered on, please run the app "CamHipro" to enter the installation interface. Tap the "add device" button, then choose "IP camera" option.



If this is the first installation of your camera, please select: "New device"; if you have already completed an installation before, please select "Device in use"", and refer to Chapter 3.3.

Now, please click "new device" and continue click "Power is on, next step".



3.2.2. Installing new camera with cable connected

Please select "Connected network cable", and the APP will automatically search for connected cameras and display them in the list. Please note that if you have installed multiple Topodome cameras in same LAN, more than one camera UID number will appear in the list. Please check the **label on the new camera** and select the camera to be installed according to the UID number on the label, it should be "SSXX-number-letter.

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Tap the UID number of the new camera to enter the device login window, where you need to enter the correct user name and password. The default user name and password are "**admin**" and "**admin**". If the default password is incorrect, it may be that the user name or password of the camera has been modified (Please reset the camera refer to the Chapter 2.4).

If the login password is OK, then tap "Add to" and you will go to wireless configuration page.


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Click the symbol ">" next to **wifi name** to enter the list of wireless routers, where the wireless router names around your camera are displayed, please **Be Careful** to choose 2.4G wireless SSID, if you choose 5G wireless SSID, wireless configuration will be invalid.

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Please enter the correct **login password** of 2.4G wireless network and click **"Configure wireless and add"** to complete the wireless configuration; if you do not want to configure the wireless connection now, you can click **"Not configured yet, add directly"**, but if you want to use the wireless connection, this step must be completed before you unplug the network cable.

Name your camera with your label or one of the default labels.




After clicking the "confirm" button, a prompt to modify the default password will appear. You can complete the password modification in the camera's setting menu.

At this time, on the control panel of the camera, "Online" should be displayed, indicating that the camera has been successfully connected to the router.

Click any blank space on the control panel to enter the video and control interface. You will see a prompt to slide your finger to control the camera rotation.

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Tap the "Know it", you will enter the control menu, just slide the windows with finger, you can find three control panels, including: 1) Screenshots/ Videos/ Dual Voice Control 2) Pan/ Tilt/ Zoom 3) Mirror/ Focus/ Preset/ Volume control/ Image adjustment/ Intelligent track




Note: In the table in chapter 3.2.4, a simple function description will be made for each function.

3.2.3. Installing new camera without cable connected

If you did not choose to connect the network cable for configuration in Chapter 3.2.2, but choose "Not connected to the network cable", then you will need to connect the phone to the hotspot of the camera to complete the subsequent wireless network configuration.

First, tap"not connected to the network cable", then choose AP network equipment and tap"Go add".




There are some differences between Android phones and iPhones in the way of connecting to the camera' s hotspot. Android phones support direct search and connection to hotspots, but Apple phones can only connect to hotspots manually. When the hotspot is successfully connected, later steps are the same for Android phones and iPhones.

-Android Phone Connect to Camera's Hotspot

After "Go add", "discover device hotspots" step will appear, if your camera just powered on, please wait for a minute, the Camera Hotspots Name will appear in the list. Tap the Hotspots name, fill the default password "01234567" for connecting the hotspots automatically.

In some cases, the hotspot will not be displayed in the list immediately. Or clicking "Go to connect" for auto connecting failed. At this time, you can **manually connect** to the hotspot to complete this step (the way is the same as the Apple mobile phone).



As above photos, please manually switch to WLAN of the Android phone, find the new camera Hotspots name: IPCAM-xxxxx (xxxxxx is same as the label of camera), fill the password "01234567", then click "Connect", Android phone will connect to the camera's hotspots.

Switch back to the CamHiPro App, you can find the device login page, and keep the default user and password as "admin", tap "Add To", App will jump to wireless setup page, the following steps please refer to the **Chapter 3.2.2**.

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Note: ①You will not find any hot spots if the camera has connected the router with the Ethernet cable. ②If the hotspot keeps not appearing, please press the reset button of the camera for more than 5 seconds to clear the original configuration and restart the operation from the first step.

-iPhones Connect to Camera's Hotspot

For Apple mobile phones, connecting to the camera hotspot can only be done manually, and the process is also very simple. First, go to the setting function of the iPhone or iPhone tablet, find the WLAN setting, and find the SSID name "IPCAM-xxxxxx" (same as your camera label).



3.3. Install a camera in use

When your camera has been set up and connected to the Internet, you can skip the steps of network configuration, and just enter the **UID number** and **password** to add the camera to the APP software.

At this time, the camera may be by your side, or it may not be in the LAN, but **anywhere in the world**, but you need to ensure that it is connected to the Internet at this time.



But be aware that if your family or colleagues have changed the password or username during the first installation, you must enter the latest login information, or you will not add the camera successfully.

When installing a camera that is already in use, you need to select "Device in use" in the following steps.


1) For the cameras that not locate in LAN network (remote cameras), please input the UID of camera manually, and input latest password, click "confirm add".


2) For the cameras that in the LAN network, just click Search nearby devices or Scan QR code, you can add the camera easily.











3.4.2.5. Features of the Toolbar

When using the landscape mode, tap the three dots in the upper right corner to enter the toolbar mode, where you can use functions including image adjustment, focus and zoom, volume adjustment, and preset positions.



3.4.3. Functions of control buttons

This table will give a brief description of each function of above buttons.

CR)	Press the video button , the camera will record the real-time video on the phone memory card, press it again, the recording will stop.
A	Press the screenshot button , the camera will save the current screen as a screenshot to the phone memory card.
⟨𝔅)	When the speaker icon is pressed, the phone will play the surrounding sound collected by the camera microphone in real time.
	When the microphone icon is pressed, the camera' s speaker will play the sound from the phone' s microphone. For example, the user can use this function to speak to the person in front of the camera. But note that when the camera and mobile phone are in the same room, there

3.4.4. Settings of the Camera

Click the gear button from main video interface or cameras list, you can go to set the basic settings, alarm settings, audio and video management, SD card recording and system settings.

3.4.4.1. Basic Settings

1) Wireless setting

Under this option, the user can view the wireless network that the current camera is connected to, or set a new wireless network and connect, but it should be noted that these networks must be

3.4.4.2. Alarm Settings - Alarm management and notification

This option can activate the phone's alarm receiving function. When an alarm is triggered, a message will be pushed to the phone.


a. Motion detection alarm:

When this option is enabled, objects moving in front of the camera will trigger an alarm, and the user can set the sensitivity and trigger area to trigger the alarm. It should be noted that motion detection alarms are often falsely triggered, such as fallen leaves and rain, so it is best to set a specific trigger area and adjust the sensitivity.

b. Audible alarm

When this option is turned on, the camera is allowed to trigger an alarm through the volume collected by the microphone. Under the same input volume, the higher the sensitivity, the easier it is to trigger an alarm. It is not recommended to set the input volume too low, because it is not easy to trigger an alarm.



c. Humanoid alarm

This option allows the camera to capture humanoid objects and alarm. This function is more accurate than motion detection and sound alarm.


The user can allow a humanoid frame to appear on the screen when an alarm occurs.

d. Alarm trigger

This option has two options: **Alone trigger** and **Linkage trigger**. If the linkage trigger is selected, the motion detection and humanoid alarm must work at the same time.

e. Alarm Planning


This option has two options: **Easy setup** and **Advantage trigger**. When easy setup is selected, the device will be triggered in any time; when advantage trigger is selected, user can make a plan for the trigger time.



3) Alarm Linkage

This option is used for the function that the camera can operate at the same time when the alarm is triggered. For example, saving the video files to to SD card.

Please note, **alarm video** will be only 15 seconds for one file.



4) Sent photos to email or FTP Server

When an alarm occurs, if the user has configured the mail server and FTP server, the camera will send alarm screenshots to the mail and FTP server. The specific mail configuration and FTP server configuration will be a bit complicated, please refer to the relevant documents on <u>www.topodome.com</u>. The number of photos sent is from 1 to 3, users can choose by themselves.

3.4.4.3. Video Setting

The default bit rate of first stream and second stream can not be changed with App, if you want to fix the bit rate (Please make sure you know the impact of doing this), please refer the chapter 4.1.1. Note: If your power format is 50hz (**Europe** or some Asian and African countries, please select the video format as 50 Hz; conversely, when the power format is 60hz (**USA** or Japan), select 60 Hz.

3.4.4.4. Audio Setting

Under this option, you can control the **microphone input** volume and **speaker output** volume. The input volume adjustment of the microphone will affect the intensity of the sound heard on the mobile phone and also affect the sound alarm function. The output volume adjustment will change the speaker volume of the camera, and sometimes users can reduce the volume without hearing too much sound.

Note:Please ignore the **linear input** option, this is a reserved function.

3.4.4.5. SD Card Plan Recording

This function is used to control how to store video files on the SD card. If you enable this option, video files will be save to SD card as specific file duration and time period.

By default, video files will be stored in the **first stream** with higher definition. **If you want to extend the recording time**, you can choose the **second stream** (that need to restart the device), this will extend the recording time by **2-3** times.

Recording period, select from 15-900 seconds, by default it is 10 minutes (600 seconds).

In the **advanced recording plan** option, you can configure the recording effective time for each day, which can effectively save the **SD card space** and cover a longer time; if the **simple plan** is selected, the recording will be recorded throughout the day and loop continuously.

It should be noted that when the space of the SD card is used up, the new file will automatically **overwrite the oldest file**, and so on.

3.4.4.6. SD Card Plan Recording

Under this option, you can check the usage of the SD card and decide whether to format the SD card.

Note: Because you cannot select some video file to delete, the only way to delete the videos is to format the SD card.

3.4.4.7. Time Setting

Time setting is a very important option. Here, you can synchronize the time with your phone.

In addition, the time zone of the camera is GMT+8 when it leaves the factory, please modify the time zone to make it consistent with your time zone. Otherwise your video file will **show the wrong time**.





3.4.5.3. Preset and Patrol Functions

Topodome Sx series cameras have 32 preset positions and one patrol lines.

Set Preset Positions:

After rotating the camera to a suitable angle, enter any number between **1-32**, and then click **"Setting**", the App will prompt that the setting is complete; in order to check whether the setting is successful, please turn the camera to For other angles, enter the position number just now and click **"Transfer**", and the camera will automatically return to the previously set position.



Set Patrol Line:

The camera has one patrol line that can be set up, the patrol line is composed of preset positions **1-16**.

In order to use the patrol line function, the user must set at least two preset positions in advance.

When the preset position is set, please enter the special call command in the App.

The call command of the **Patrol line is 76**.

Important note: Please do not use the patrol function for a long time to prevent damage to the machine motor.

Clear the Preset Settings:

When you want to clear all the preset positions, you can use command **92**, enter and use this command, the preset positions will all be deleted.

Stop the Patrol:

When the user wants to stop the patrol function, he only needs to manually control the camera to rotate, or call a fixed preset position, and the patrol function will be stopped.

4. Setup Camera with CMS Software

Note:The Hip2p Client software does not support hotspot installation, so before installing the camera, you must ensure that the cameras are powered on and connected to the router with a network cable (in the Same LAN as your computer).

The Hip2p Client software has windows version and Mac version, Please visit the website **www.topodome.com/support** and download CMS management software pack. Unzip the file pack, you can get some files like these.

The Client_setup_xxx.exe file will be installed on windows OS.







As shown in the figure above, one camera is successfully added, and the other camera displays a **password error** when it is added, which requires manual modification of the password to gain control of the camera.



Click the fifth button. This is the **configuration function**.

On the right side of the pop-up screen, select the camera that cannot be connected, click the **Modify Device** button, and then enter the **correct camera password** or the correct user name in the edit interface.



After clicking OK, and return to the video window.

1)For **Windows OS**, you will find that the camera is still offline. Please right-click on the UID name of the camera on the left. The right-click menu will pop up. Please click the **Connect Device** button.



If the password is correct, the camera video will be displayed successfully and device status will be online.



2)For **Mac OS**, when change the password and return to video windows, the camera will be connected automatically and display video immediately (if the password is right).



3)For **Mac OS**, sometimes there is only one default video window. At this time, you can click the icon in the lower right corner to select the number of windows displayed at the same time.



4.3. Install Remote Cameras (Not Same LAN) with HiP2P Client

Sometimes, you have installed the camera in other places, such as vacation houses, offices, etc., then the software will not be installed automatically, and you need to add it manually (Please refer to the chapter 3.3).

Before remote installation, you must ensure that the camera is connected to the Internet and powered on, and you also know the UID information and password of the camera.






4.4. Delete Cameras in HiP2P Client





5.9. Remote Web Access

When the camera you want to access remotely is on WLAN (refer to chapter 3.3), it will be more difficult to access with a browser, you have to use UPnP/DDNS functionality or Port Forwarding.

Before using UPnP/DDNS functionality, ensure your router should support the uPnP networking protocol and the protocol should be enabled. Please refer to your router manufacturer's documentation to learn how to enable UPnP.

Login the camera via web browser, go to the "Settings" ->"Network"->"DDNS" page to enable the UPnP and enter the information of a third-party's DDNS, such as "Dyndns.org", "3322.org", "dynddns.us", or "No-ip.com". Click Apply to save the settings. Then you can access the camera by DDNS remotely.

Port Forwarding is another method to set up remote access. It is required to make settings on both the camera and your router. 
